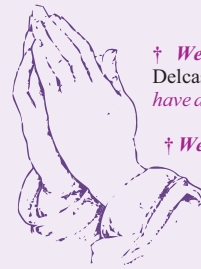
BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT TEAM:

ROSA LI PETRI

(2/2/1926 – 8/5/2015)

Rosa was born 2nd February 1926 in Menfi Italy where she spent her life growing up. Rosa met and married the love of her life Giuseppe in Italy where they then moved in the late 50's to Melbourne Carlton to start their married life. Rosa joined the Italian club in Noble Park where she made many friends and spent years at the club every Friday. One of the games they would play was bingo and Rosa was the lady who called the numbers out and she truly enjoyed her participation in the game. She was so loved and respected with in the club. As Rosa progressed into old age she spent her remaining 5 years of her life in Regis nursing home in North Dandenong which she continued to play bingo but unfortunately was not the one to call out the numbers. Sadly 2 months before she died Rosa had a nasty fall which unfortunately she NEVER recuperated from and sadly went down hill in her health every day. Her family were there for her, all the way right up till the end, Rosa died peacefully in her bed with her family at her bed side.
