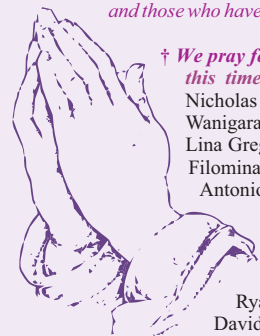
PRAYER REQUESTS - SICK, DEATH OR ANNIVERSARY LISTS
