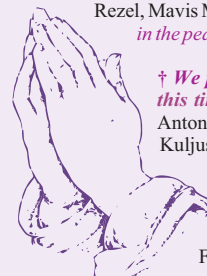
PRAYER REQUESTS - SICK, DEATH OR ANNIVERSARY LISTS

needy families in our area.

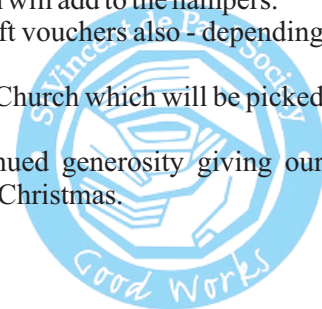
The gifts were donated by
