WHAT'S HAPPENING...

We have begun our Lenten journey leading to Easter; a time for Prayer, Fasting and Almsgiving. This season is a time to be filled with Joy and anticipation that God's Love for us will sustain us in times of the Cross of life's challenges.

At our recent Liturgy meeting, we discussed how our Masses would be shaped over these weeks. Lent is about simplicity therefore, as we agreed, no flowers in preparation for the many flowers at Easter. The altar will be dressed in our new purple altar cloth. Thanks to Pauline and Sandra who have shopped and made these beautiful cloths for our community.

Music and singing will be simple. Resurrection will sing Entrance, Communion and Recessional. At St Anthony's the ministers will process in in silence. The Gospel Book will process in and be placed on the Altar. There will be no parts of the Mass sung. Hymns sung will be Psalm, Communion and Recessional.

The projector screen will be used as a Church banner, with our weekly Lenten theme upon it. The projector will only be used where necessary, as it can be a distraction in the Mass. Songs will be on the screen, along with the response to the Psalm, the Creed and St Anthony's Prayer.

During Lent, to assist us in our Prayer journey, there will be Stations of the Cross on Friday nights. Resurrection will begin with Mass at 6.00pm, Quiet Time at 6.30pm and Stations at 7pm (*starting Friday 27/2*). St Anthony's will

continue their Friday morning 9.30 Mass, Stations in French at 6.00pm, Quiet time at 6.30pm and Stations at 7.00pm (*starting Friday 20/2*).

At the meeting, we discussed the practice of covering the Cross and Statues in Lent. We researched this last year and discovered that veiling during all of Lent may have been a common practice in the Middle Ages, but it has been restricted to Passion Week (*if required*) for several centuries. We agreed that the covering of images will only happen in Holy Week. Our communities are very strong in their practice to touch Statues and Icons etc. Having them uncovered during Lent will leave them accessible for longer.

During this week, the new Tabernacle and Sanctuary lamp were installed in Resurrection's new Church. In the next couple of weeks, the altar will be installed, then the lectern a week or so after that. The Baptism font and holy water font are in their final stages for completion.

We welcome home St Anthony's grade 5-6 students, numerous staff and parents and Fr Sang who travelled to Canberra by bus last Monday and returned home on Friday. They visited Parliament House and learnt about Australia's political process. They visited the National Shrine and Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Australian Sport Institute and much more. Thanks to all the people who made this possible.
