WHAT'S HAPPENING...

THE PASCHAL (EASTER) CANDLE

The term "Paschal" comes from the Hebrew word for Passover. It is sometimes referred to as the "Easter candle" or the "Christ candle."

At the opening of the Easter Vigil a "new fire" is lit and blessed. The Paschal candle is the first candle to be lit with a flame from this fire, representing the light of Christ coming into the world. This represents the risen Christ, as a symbol of light (life) dispelling darkness (death). This candle is traditionally the one from which all other lights are taken for the Easter service.

It is the largest candle in the worship space. Often, the candle will display several common symbols:

1. The cross is always the central symbol, most clearly identifying it as the Paschal candle.
2. The Greek letters alpha and omega signify that God is the beginning and the end. Christ belongs all time and for all ages.
3. The current year represents God in the present amidst the congregation.
4. Five grains of incense may be embedded in the candle

to represent the five wounds of Jesus.

The candle remains lit at all worship services throughout Easter season. After the Easter season, it is frequently placed near the baptismal font. The Paschal candle is also lit during baptisms, funeral services and significant occasions for the local community.

Our Parishes' Easter Candles reflect the symbols mentioned above. In decorating our candles this year, we have included two dominant themes being the themes of "Peace" and "Encounter". Our candles of peace have been circulating through our parishes over the past months and remind us of the urgent need that the world has for peace. The other theme of encounter, represented mainly by the symbol of the hands, represents our need to truly encounter our fellow neighbour and our God.

Make some time over the coming weeks to take a close look at our candles. Thank you to Margaret at St Anthony's and Talia at Resurrection for preparing our Easter candles for us. Easter blessings to you and those you love.
