### A WEEKEND WITH A DIFFERENCE

Resurrection Parish hosted their First 'Men Alive' Weekend in the Resurrection School last weekend. Glen D'Cunha, a member of the Men Alive team introduced the program to a group of men who became the Resurrection Committee. Well done, you achieved so much. Several weeks of planning in preparation for the weekend saw our weekend a very successful one.



All day Saturday and on Sunday morning, we hosted 48 men who accepted our invitation to be present. The Men Alive Team, 2 from Tassie and 2 from Victoria led the weekend. There were several sessions where the presenter shared an experience on a particular theme. Then in small groups, our local men spoke of how the session challenged them.

The hope of the Men Alive experience is that it allows the men to become better men, in relationship, family, work and Church. Thank you to the men who participated, may you be blessed and enriched through your experience. To the Men Alive Committee, thank you for your generous response, honesty and leadership. To those who worked behind the scenes in planning, set up and catering. Thank you to the Resurrection school, thank you for the use of your wonderful school facility.

2.30pm Sunday afternoon, St Anthony's hosted an African Mass for all Africans in Victoria, nearly 400 people attended. It was a lovely celebration, full of colour, music, songs and dances. People came from many parts of Africa, as refugees and asylum seekers.

Many calling Australia home – while many others one day hope to return to their place of origin, when it is safe.

The Archbishop Office's for Evangelisation brought to Melbourne Cardinal Napier, from South Africa, in the hope of gathering all the African communities from around Victoria. St Anthony's was asked to host the celebration because we have the South Sudanese Mass on the 1st and 3rd Sunday of each month. Thank you to our South Sudanese community under the guidance of Deacon George Piech Meat who led the celebration in song, music, dance and hospitality.

Congratulations to the men and women who were commissioned as catechists.

Cardinal Napier, a very graceful man with great presence was the principal celebrant. 8 priests from around Melbourne, 2 deacons and 12 seminarians. The Cardinal asked us to remember Africa in prayers for healing and peace. He challenged the community to respond positively to the opportunity given to them by Australia. He acknowledged their heartache, pain and wounds they hold and carry with them and the sacrifice they have made. He reminded the community that God has brought you here for a reason, embrace it and serve God and Australia well.

May this community be blessed, and may they find a warm welcome here.
