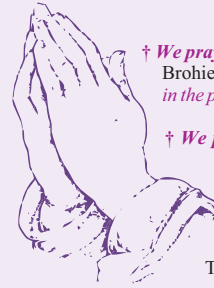
PARISH MINIBUS SERVICES: DRIVERS REQUIRED
