WHAT'S HAPPENING...

As you read this, Holy Week has begun. Our preparation over the past five weeks climaxes this weekend as we move from preparing our hearts and minds for Easter, to journeying with Jesus through the joys, the trials, and the sufferings of Holy Week.

It might seem a little odd that we read the Passion of Jesus on Palm Sunday, and then, four days later, we seem to go backwards in time as we hear the story of Jesus at the Last Supper, before hearing once again of his arrest by the authorities, the trial before Pilate, and his crucifixion. For those of us who are able to attend the Easter Triduum ceremonies, there is a shifting in our mindset from the joy of the entry into Jerusalem, to the sorrow of the Passion, back to the anxiety of the Last Supper, and forward into the Passion and Crucifixion before we 'finally' hear the story of Jesus' resurrection. It 'messes with your head'.

In spite of this, we are invited to journey with Jesus, in contrast to him journeying with us throughout our lives. We are invited to support Jesus throughout his most challenging week, to be present with him and the Apostles at the last supper, to pray with him in Gethsemane, to walk with him to Calvary, before walking out of the tomb with him on Easter Sunday. What a journey we have waiting for us!

At Resurrection Parish, we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus in our new church for the first time. At St. Anthony's, we keep Resurrection parishioners in prayer during this very exciting period.
