WHAT'S HAPPENING

At Saint Anthony's...

Over the past 2 weeks, the overall organising committee and the liturgy preparation team have held meetings for the preparation of St Anthony's feast Day. We will be celebrating the Feast Day on the weekend of 13/14 June.

The nine day Novena leading up to the Feast Fay will be conducted as in previous years.

The Liturgy Team have prepared the liturgy at St Anthony's for all the Masses on the weekend. At the conclusion of the 11am Mass, there will be an opportunity for those wishing to participate in a procession with the statue of St Anthony, following the same route as last year - from the church, down Raymond Street and returning to the church via Agnes Street.

Over recent years, many thousands of dollars have been spent each year on the provision of a fully catered meal, which has been served free of charge. The Organising Committee had extensive discussion as to an alternate way of honouring St Anthony agreed the money to serve the poor in the spirit of St Anthony.

It was unanimously decided that we would invite those who are able to assist by donating food to share in a simpler meal for those who are celebrating the Feast Day. This may be in the form of sandwiches, cakes, finger food or casseroles, etc. The Men's Club have accepted an invitation to cook and serve BBQ sausages on the day.

If you are able to assist with the donation of food for the lunch, please sign the forms in the foyer after Mass or leave a message at the Parish Centre indicating what you can supply.

Whilst we appreciate that many have enjoyed the catered meal in the past, we are sure those celebrating the Feast of St Anthony this year will be pleased to know that the financial donation we will be able to make instead to feed the hungry and care for the vulnerable is an appropriate response for us to make, following the inspiration given by St Anthony.
