Life at the parish has been fairly busy with Brian away this week on his annual leave. He is enjoying a well earned break and will return to parish life on the weekend of 2nd November.

At Resurrection, Vicki attended the site meeting for the new church this week. Things are progressing well. Windows will be going in shortly and the plaster work will also be done in the next couple of weeks. There has been some speculation about the flattening of the grounds in front of the current church... some thinking it is a car park... but no... it will all be landscaped. There will be a driveway that goes across the front of the current and new church that links the 2 driveways to enable access for funerals, weddings and disabled drop off at church. The builders are working well towards a December finish.

Over the coming weeks we will be seeking your support for the provision of seating in the church. Currently we have donations for 12 seats out of 408 needed. As we don't want to play "musical chairs", we are seeking sponsorship of a seat from our parishioners at Resurrection (and St Anthony's if you feel so inclined). Seats with padding are \$320.00. We are very grateful for the generosity of all who have contributed to our new church so far...from both parishes... you continue to amaze us with your response.

At St Anthony's things are well under way for the carnival. Please consider if you can respond to the requests in the newsletter or sell some raffle tickets. This is a great opportunity to be active in the community. The rewards of participating in this way not only benefit the parish but also those who participate.

A big thank you to all those who signed up for our liturgy related ministries. We are processing them now for the new rosters .

Another opportunity to participate is an invitation we are extending to all parishioners to be involved in a new parish religious education group. This group will be involved in the sacramental, catechetical and faith formation life of the parish.
