WHAT'S HAPPENING...

The month of November has traditionally been devoted as a month of Remembrance. We begin the month with All Saints Day, November 2 and All Souls Day, when we commemorate all who have died. We are reminded in the Creed said at Mass each Sunday of the "Communion of Saints", of our unity and connectedness with all who have gone before us. As a nation, we celebrate Remembrance Day on November 11, when we remember all those who have lost their lives in war. Towards the end of the month, both parishes will celebrate a special memorial Mass where we invite, in particular, those who have lost a loved one to death in the preceding year.

Last week, Longinus made the announcement that he would be leaving us on November 26 to take up an appointment at Heidelberg parish, as part time assistant priest and part time student. Longinus received the phone call from the Vicar General late Saturday afternoon and spoke to Brian on Saturday evening. He was able to announce his appointment at the Sunday Masses that he celebrated. He will no doubt share more information with the Masses he celebrates this weekend.

At St Anthony's the preparations for the Carnival are in full swing. Don't forget to check out how you can be involved, either by donating to the stalls or offering to serve on a stall on the day. Leave a message at the parish office and we will pass it on.

We are currently processing the sign up for ministry sheets. The new rosters will take effect from the 1st Sunday in

Advent, 29/30 November, which is the start of the new liturgical year. The rosters will be distributed prior to this date. In the meantime, the current rosters will remain in place and will continue until Advent.

At Resurrection, we are calling for volunteers to assist with a sausage sizzle on election day, 29 November. Our hall is being used as a polling centre. The money raised will go towards a new Christmas Crib for the new church. We ask you to volunteer one hour of your time to assist. A sign-up sheet with allocated times is available on the back table at the church.

Also at Resurrection, our parish working bee will be held on Saturday 22 November from 9.30-11.30, followed by refreshments. A sign-up sheet is also on the back table for this activity. Lots to be done to get ready for Christmas and the opening of our new Church. Speaking of our new church, our purchased seat count stands at 25... only 373 to go! Pledge forms are available at the back of the church with credit card arrangements included if that is your preference.

Enjoy the Cup Day Holiday for those fortunate enough to not be working. If you have a flutter on the horses, we hope you back a winner! Prayers and blessings to all students who are doing their exams this week. Take care on the roads if you are out and about.

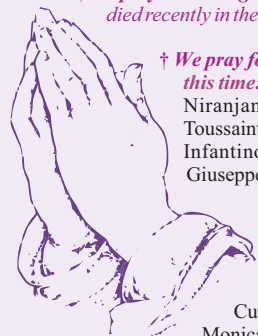
PASTORAL ASSOCIATE FULL TIME NEGOTIABLE
