The next batch of 2015 Columban calendars have arrived, so please pay and collect yours at the back of the church.

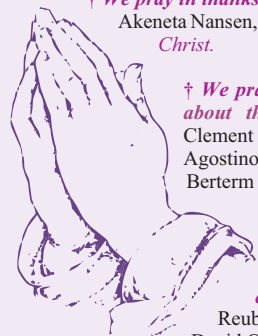
PRAYER REQUESTS - SICK, DEATH OR ANNIVERSARY LISTS
